MERIL's Adult Brain Injury (ABI) independent living program assists individuals who have a Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) with setting and achieving their own goals, learning about community resources, and socializing with peers.

Eligibility Requirements

- A Missouri resident
 - Age 21-65
 - Meet medical eligibility guidelines for Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)
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Service coordination includes:

- Assessment of needs
 - Development of a plan
 - Assistance finding resources such as:
 - Medical care
 - Housing
 - Counseling
 - Transportation
 - Rehabilitation
 - Vocational training
 - Cognitive / Behavior training

Additional transitional home and community support training is available to those who are income-eligible for Rehabilitation Services.



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
